

2020 CLASS AND AWARD POINTS RULES

MEMBERSHIP

*#1. **For points to count** all pintos must be PtHA registered and owned or leased by MSPB&O members. All listed horse owners, all listed lessees, all exhibitors including youth and PtHA walk/trot, PtHA open and amateur must have a current MSPB&O and PtHA membership for points to count for show and annual awards. In addition, to be eligible for YA and AM show awards and certain year end awards, membership in those clubs is also required. **All-Breed exhibitors must belong to MSPB&O for points to count for show and annual high point awards.**

*#2. Official copies of the current PtHA approved Horse Lease and/or Family Relationship Forms must be on file with MSPB&O and the annual PtHA AM, YA, Open and MSPB&O membership must be paid before points will count.

*#3. Membership begins on the date the membership is paid & must be received by the Show Office before the start of the show for that show's points to count for that show and for annual awards.

#4. For the All-Breed Division - only the exhibitor must be a member of MSPB&O.

#5. For Lead-Line and Participation awards, only the Horse Owner or Lessee must be members of MSPB&O.

QUALIFYING SHOWS - FOR ALL ANNUAL AWARDS (excluding Lead-line & Participaton awards)

The qualifying shows are **SPRING KICK-OFF, PINT-O-RAMA, SUMMER CLASSIC, CLASS IN THE COUNTRY, AND FALL WIND-UP**. **A horse must show & place on a judges card in the same class over 3 weekends** of MSPB&O sponsored shows to qualify for year-end awards. The awards will be given in accordance with the classes listed on the MSPB&O show schedule. If any classes are combined during the show season, the points will be tabulated under the original class names/numbers as listed on the show schedule. For lead-line and participation awards there is no 3 show requirement; if they participate in 1 show and the Horse Owner/Lessee is a MSPB&O member the lead-line and participation youth are eligible for an annual award.

HALTER

Champion & Reserve Halter points to be included ONLY in Annual Champion & Reserve Halter AND Horse of the Year Award

GRAND CHAMPION Halter of each sex and type division will be awarded four points if there are at least three horses in the qualifying halter classes in the same sex, age group or conformation type, or if there are at least three entrants competing for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion.

RESERVE CHAMPION Halter will receive three points if there are at least three horses in the qualifying halter classes in the same sex, age group or conformation type, or if there are at least three entrants competing for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion.

NOVICE

PtHA Novice Amateur and Novice Youth points are not added to any PtHA ROM or All-Breed group for any MSPB&O show or annual high point awards.

HIGH POINT & RESERVE ANNUAL AWARDS -- FOR *PTHA & #ALL-BREED DIVISIONS

These awards are for annual high-point. Exhibitors must be MSPB&O members and **place on a judges card in the same class over a number of board-determined weekends** of MSPB&O sponsored shows to qualify for year-end awards. Lead-line & participation awards have a one-show requirement and the horse owner/lessee is a MSPB&O member.

- A. *Champion & Reserve Halter Horse – 3 divisions: Stock, Hunter, and Pleasure/Saddle.
- B. *Champion & Reserve High Point Youth – 2 divisions – Junior Youth 13 & Under and Senior Youth 14 – 18.
- C. *Champion & Reserve High Point Amateur – 3 divisions – Junior, Senior, and Elite Exhibitor.
- D. *Champion & Reserve English Performance Pleasure/Saddle Horse - combined points in Open ROM English performance horse classes except Trail.
- E. *Champion & Reserve Western Performance Pleasure/Saddle Horse – most combined points in Open ROM Western performance horse classes except Trail.
- F. *Champion & Reserve English Performance Stock/Hunter Horse – most combined points in Open ROM English performance classes except Trail.
- G. *Champion & Reserve Western Performance Stock/Hunter Horse – most combined points in Open ROM Western performance classes except Trail.
- H. *Champion & Reserve Open Solid Registry Horse – most combined points in Open ROM Solid Registry classes including Halter and Trail.
- I. *High Point Youth of the Year – most combined points from all ROM Youth classes.
- J. *High Point Amateur of the Year – most combined points from all ROM Amateur classes.
- K. *Horse of the Year – most combined points from all Open Pinto ROM horse classes including Trail and Grand & Reserve Halter.
- L. *Champion & Reserve PtHA Walk/Trot Adult – most combined points in ROM Walk/Trot classes.
- M. *Champion & Reserve PtHA Walk/Trot Youth 10 & U – most combined points in ROM Walk/Trot classes.
- N. #Champion & Reserve All-Breed Walk/Trot 12 & Under – most combined points in Walk/Trot classes.
- O. #Champion & Reserve All-Breed Walk/Trot 13 & Over – most combined points in Walk/Trot classes.
- P. #Champion & Reserve All-Breed Youth 18 & Under – most combined points in 18 & Under classes.
- Q. #Champion & Reserve All Breed Adult 19 & Over – most combined points in 19 & Over classes.
- R. #Champion & Reserve All-Breed Pony/Miniature – most combined points in Pony/Mini, all ages.
- S. #Overall All-Breed Horse Of The Year – most combined points from all classes (1 horse/exhibitor pair only).
- T. #Lead-line and Participation Awards – in order of combined points for award placings. Lead-line and Participation Awards have a one-show requirement and only the Horse Owner/Lessee must be MSPB&O member

2020 Challenge Classes Canceled due to COVID-19 (PtHA & ALL-BREED Challenge Trophies)

1. **All listed horse owners, all listed lessees, youth, amateur and all-breed exhibitors must have a MSPB&O membership for points to count for the Challenge competition.**
2. **PtHA Amateur must be a member of MPtAA, MSPB&O, and PtHA for Amateur challenge.**
3. **PtHA Youth must be a member of MPYC, MSPB&O and PtHA for Youth challenge.**
4. PtHA Exhibitors must place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd, in the same class at 2 shows to qualify. The qualifying shows are Spring Kick-Off, Pint-O-Rama, Summer Classic, and Class In The Country.
5. All-Breed Exhibitor must belong to MSPB&O and must place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd, in the same class at 2 shows to qualify. The qualifying shows: Spring Kick-Off, Pint-O-Rama, Summer Classic, and Class In Country.
6. Classes will be organized and judged at the Fall Wind-Up Show. Only the winner will be announced. This is not a ROM point class and there is no entry fee.

YEAR END AWARDS FOR *PtHA & #ALL-BREED DIVISIONS

Year-end awards are based on the number of MSPB&O points earned by each exhibitor/horse (or mini/pony) pair. Also, PtHA National points do not relate to our club program. It is our goal to give as many awards as possible to as many of our MSPB&O members as possible. MSPB&O points are used to determine the annual top six places in each class for all shows attended. Any ties within a placing in a class will be awarded where they tied. Year End awards will be determined by the awards committee and based on the budgeted amount for that current year for awards.

- A. For Open PtHA classes the year end award is awarded to the listed registered owner(s) or current listed lessee of the horse.
- B. For All Breed awards the exhibitor must be a MSPB&O member
- C. Horses that have multiple exhibitors and/or multiple owners/lessee(s) are awarded by exhibitor/horse pair. The only exceptions to this are lead line & participation awards which are awarded to the exhibitor.
